CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



Definitions:

Adult: This includes a person who is 18 years or older on the event day

Child: Defined as a person who is younger than 18 on the event day

The Organiser(s): Organiser(s) of the Amazing Race is Carla Kraft

Terms and Conditions:

Age Limits:

- Persons under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian sign the Entry Form and consent to their participation in the Amazing Race @ Piekfijn.
- All teams must have at least one person above 18 years old in their team.

Waiver and acknowledgement of risks involved:

You acknowledge that walking/running and participating in the Amazing Race may be a dangerous activity and involves inherent risks.

You agree that you are solely responsible for your own safety and, where relevant, the safety of your child or minors under your supervision. The organisers accept no responsibility for any injury, death, damage and/or loss that you or your child might sustain or incur during the Amazing Race howsoever arising (including as a result of the negligence of The organisers, the sponsors or each of their representatives).

You and, where relevant, your child hereby release, indemnify and exempt the organisers, the sponsors and each of their representatives from all liability whether arising from negligence or otherwise in connection with your or, where relevant, your child's participation in this event.

If you are acting as the guardian for a child, you consent to that child participating in the Amazing Race. You also agree that you take full and sole responsibility for that child's safety and participation in the Amazing Race.

Compliance with laws:

During the Amazing Race, you must comply with all:

- All directions issued by the Police; and
- All lawful directions issued by The organisers concerning health and safety

Preparation, training, health Safety and other issues:

It is each participant's sole responsibility to ensure that they have adequately and appropriately prepared themselves physically and mentally for the Amazing Race. If you have any health issues or doubts about your health prior to the Amazing Race you should immediately seek appropriate medical advice.

By undertaking or participating on the Amazing Race and completing the Participant Entry Form, you agree that you are physically and mentally capable of participating on the Amazing Race. You also undertake that you have sufficient competence to participate in the Amazing Race. If during the Amazing Race you become ill or have an accident, The organisers will arrange medical transport at your own expense, usually in an ambulance. Please be aware that ambulance transport can be very expensive.

Common Sense:

You must participate in a safe and responsible manner during the Amazing Race and use common sense at all times. You should exercise caution and operate defensively and courteously.

Special Requirements:

We welcome people with disabilities on the Amazing Race and ask that other participants show the same consideration and support they would expect to receive from other participants. The organisers will use all reasonable endeavors to cater for your particular disability where it is reasonably able to.

Behavior:

The organisers consider the following behavior to be unacceptable and inappropriate:

- Any behavior which threatens the safety of other participants, volunteers and staff.
 - Failing to obey any lawful direction of The organisers or its officials
 - Behavior which confronts or offends other people including without limitation discriminatory actions or conducts (on any basis), sexual harassment, name calling, foul language and fighting, etc.
 - Underage smoking or smoking anywhere other than in the designated smoking areas
 - Any other behavior or conduct which in the reasonable opinion of the organisers is inappropriate in the circumstances.
- Conduct which, in the reasonable opinion of the organisers, is inappropriate in accordance with the above standards may result in expulsion from the Amazing Race.

Refusal of entry:

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to the Amazing Race to any person regardless of whether they hold a valid entry.

Animals:

NO animals are permitted except guide dogs for visually impaired.

Photography: Participants understand and agree that they may be photographed or filmed and that The organisers may use this footage or future promotional needs by coming on the Amazing Race and signing the entry. Participants agree to the creation and use of which footage for future The organisers promotions and publicity.

Protecting your privacy The organisers will not disclose any personal information to other parties unless we are legally obliged to.
